OPINION AND FINDINGS

On October 20, 2004, Owest Communications (Owest) of Denver, Colorado, filed an application seeking approval of its Amendment to its Interconnection Agreement for Elimination of UNE-P and Implementation of Batch Hot Cut Process and Discounts Telecommunications LLC Granite (Granite) of Ouincy, Massachusetts, previously granted at Application No. C-3054.Notice of the application was published in The Daily Record, Omaha, Nebraska, on October 25, 2004. No protests were filed; therefore, this application is processed pursuant to Commission's Rule of Modified Procedure.

On January 13, 2004, pursuant to Application No. C-3054, the original interconnection agreement between Qwest and Granite was approved by this Commission. In the current application, Qwest and Granite seek to amend the agreement by adding terms and conditions to their existing interconnection agreement. An executed copy of the amendment is contained within the application.

The amendment does not discriminate against any telecommunications carrier. Furthermore, the implementation of the amendment is consistent with the public interest, convenience and necessity.

Section 252(e) of the Act requires this Commission to review negotiated interconnection agreements to ensure they comply with Sections 251 and 252(d) of the Act, as well as all applicable state laws. Using those standards, the amendment filed October 20, 2004, should be approved.

ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that the amendment to the interconnection agreement between Qwest Communications and Granite Telecommunications LLC, be, and it is hereby, approved.
