BY THE COMMISSION:

By application filed November 15, 2004, United States Advanced Telecom, Inc. (USAT) of Norcross, Georgia, seeks to cancel its authority to operate as a resale carrier of intrastate interLATA and intraLATA telecommunications services within the state of Nebraska, previously granted in Application C-2004. Notice of the application was published in The Daily Record, Omaha, Nebraska, on November 16, 2004. No protests were filed; therefore, this application is processed pursuant to the Commission's Rule of Modified Procedure.

OPINION AND FINDINGS

On March 30, 1999, USAT was granted a Certificate of Authority to provide resold interexchange telecommunications services within the State of Nebraska, pursuant to Application No. C-2004.

By letter received on November 15, 2004, USAT requested the withdrawal of its Certificate of Authority. USAT no longer has customers in Nebraska and does not intend to resell its telecommunications services in Nebraska.

Upon consideration of the request and being fully advised, the Commission finds the request to be reasonable and finds that USAT's Certificate of Authority previously granted in Application C-2004 should be canceled.

ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that Application No. C-3303 be, and it is hereby, granted and the Certificate of Authority previously granted to United Systems Access Telecom, Inc., is canceled.
