BY THE COMMISSION:

By application filed November 29, 2004, Econodial, LLC (Econodial), New York, New York, seeking to withdrawal its authority as an interexchange carrier in the state of Nebraska, previously granted in Application C-2763. Notice of the application was published in The Daily Record, Omaha, Nebraska, on December 1, 2004. No protests were filed; therefore, this application is processed pursuant to the Commission's Rule of Modified Procedure.

O P I N I O N A N D F I N D I N G S

On August 20, 2002, Econodial was granted a Certificate of Authority to provide resold interexchange telecommunications services within the State of Nebraska, pursuant to Application C-2763.

By letter received on November 29, 2004, Econodial requested the withdrawal of its Certificate of Authority. Econodial no longer has customers in Nebraska and does not intend to resell its telecommunications services in Nebraska.

Upon consideration of the request and being fully advised, the Commission finds the request to be reasonable and finds that Econodial's Certificate of Authority previously granted in Application No. C-2763 should be canceled.

O R D E R

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that Application C-3312 be, and it is hereby, granted and the certificate of authority previously granted to Econodial, LLC, is canceled.
