BY THE COMMISSION:

By application filed December 10, 2004, Phonetec PCS, LLC, (Phonetec) of Midland, Texas, seeks withdrawal of its authority to operate as a resale common carrier of telecommunications services within the State of Nebraska previously granted in Docket No. C-3161. Notice of the application was published in The Daily Record, Omaha, Nebraska, on December 22, 2004. No protests were filed; therefore, this application is processed pursuant to the Commission's Rule of Modified Procedure.

O P I N I O N     A N D     F I N D I N G S

On May 4, 2004, Phonetec was granted a Certificate of Authority to provide resold interexchange telecommunications services within the State of Nebraska, pursuant to Application C-3161.

By letter received on December 10, 2004, Phonetec requested the withdrawal of its Certificate of Authority. Phonetec no longer has long distance customers in Nebraska and does not intend to resell its interexchange telecommunications services in Nebraska.

Upon consideration of the request and being fully advised, the Commission finds the request to be reasonable and finds that Phonetec's Certificate of Authority previously granted in Application No. C-3161 should be canceled.

O R D E R

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that Application C-3319 be, and it is hereby, granted and the Certificate of Authority previously granted to Phonetec PCS, LLC, is canceled.
