O P I N I O N A N D F I N D I N G S

On January 21, 2005, Qwest Corporation (Qwest) of Denver, Colorado, filed an application seeking approval of its Amendment to the Interconnection Agreement for Elimination of UNE-P and Implementation of Batch Hot Cut Process and Discounts with 1-800-Reconnex, Inc. d/b/a USTel (USTel) of Hubbard, Oregon, previously granted in Application No. C-3219. Notice of the application was published in The Daily Record, Omaha, Nebraska, on January 26, 2005. No protests were filed; therefore, this application is processed pursuant to the Commission's Rule of Modified Procedure.

On July 20, 2004, pursuant to Application C-3219, the original interconnection agreement between Qwest and USTel was approved by this Commission. In the current application, Qwest seeks to amend the agreement by eliminating UNE-P and adding terms and rates for Batch Hot Cut Process and Discounts. An executed copy of the amendment is contained within the application.

The amendment does not discriminate against any telecommunications carrier. Furthermore, the implementation of the amendment is consistent with the public interest, convenience and necessity.

Section 252(e) of the Act requires this Commission to review negotiated interconnection agreements to ensure they comply with Sections 251 and 252(d) of the Act, as well as all applicable state laws. Using those standards, the amendment filed January 21, 2005, should be approved.

O R D E R

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that the amendment to the interconnection agreement between Qwest Corporation and 1-800-Reconnex, Inc. d/b/a USTeL, be, and it is hereby, approved.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the executed amendment filed herein be, and it is hereby, made the official copy on file with the Nebraska Public Service Commission.
