## OPINION AND FINDINGS

On February 16, 2005, a joint application was filed by Qwest Corporation (Qwest) of Denver, Colorado, and McImetro Access Transmission Services, LLC, (MCI) of Englewood, Colorado, seeking a Commercial Line Sharing Amendment to the Interconnection Agreement pursuant to section 252(i) of the Telecommunications Act of 1996. Notice of the application was published in <a href="The Daily Record">The Daily Record</a>, Omaha, Nebraska, on February 24, 2005. No protests were filed; therefore, this application is processed pursuant to the Commission's Rule of Modified Procedure.

On April 11, 2000, the original interconnection agreement between Qwest and MCI was approved by this Commission, pursuant to Application No. C-2257. In the current application, Qwest and MCI seek to amend their agreement. Executed copies of the amendment are contained within the application.

The amendment does not discriminate against any telecommunications carrier that is not a party to the agreement. Furthermore, the implementation of the amendment is consistent with the public interest, convenience and necessity.

Section 252(e) of the Act requires this Commission to review negotiated interconnection agreements to ensure they comply with Sections 251 and 252(d) of the Act, as well as all applicable state laws. Using those standards, the amendment filed should be approved.

## ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that the Commercial Line Sharing Amendment to the interconnection agreement between Qwest Corporation and MCImetro Access Transmission Services, LLC, be, and is hereby, approved.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the executed amendment filed herein be, and it is hereby, made the official copy on file with the Nebraska Public Service Commission.
