## OPINION AND FINDINGS

By application filed February 28, 2005, Adelphia Telecommunications, Inc. (Adelphia) of Greenwood, Colorado, seeks to discontinue interexchange telecommunications services in the state of Nebraska. Notice of the application appeared in <a href="https://doi.org/10.1001/jhear.2005">The Daily Record</a> on March 8, 2005. No protests were filed, therefore this application is processed pursuant to the Commission's rule of Modified Procedure.

Pursuant to Application No. C-2207, Adelphia was granted authority to operate as an interexchange carrier of telecommunications services in Nebraska. As Adelphia has no customers in Nebraska, the proposed discontinuance of service will not affect the provision of long distance service in any of those geographic areas.

Upon review of the application and circumstances presented, the Commission is of the opinion that Adelphia Telecommunications, Inc.'s request should be honored and its certificate should be cancelled.

## ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that Application No. C-3380 be and it is hereby granted and the certificate of operating authority previously issued in Application No. C-2207 be cancelled.
