On September 23, 2003, in Application C-3003, Capsule Communications, Inc. (Capsule or Applicant), Bensalem, Pennsylvania, was issued a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity to operate as a resale common carrier of telecommunications services in the state of Nebraska.
