BY THE COMMISSION:

On April 25, 2005, an application was filed by Pacific Centrex Services, Inc. (Pacific or Applicant), North Hollywood, California, seeking a certificate of authority to operate as an interexchange carrier of telecommunications services within the state of Nebraska. Notice of the application was published in The Daily Record, Omaha, Nebraska, on April 26, 2005. No protests were filed; therefore, this application is processed pursuant to the Commission's Rules of Modified Procedure.

OPINION AND FINDINGS

Applicant is a California corporation headquartered in North Hollywood, California, and is authorized by the Secretary of State to operate in Nebraska as a foreign corporation.

Applicant seeks authority to operate as a reseller of interLATA and intraLATA intrastate services to the public on a statewide basis. Applicant seeks authority to offer a full range of 1+ interexchange telecommunications services on a resale basis. Specifically, Applicant seeks authority to provide switched inbound, switched outbound, out-WATS, in WATS, and calling card services. Applicant does not intend to provide operator services, 900 or 700 services. Applicant owns no transmission facilities. Applicant will offer service to its subscribers using facilities of the communications networks of Global Crossing or other facilities-based IXCs and local exchange carriers.

Applicant states it has extensive managerial, financial and technical experience with which to execute the business plan described herein. The Applicant agrees to adhere to all state laws and all Commission policies rules and orders. Applicant further states a grant of the application would serve the public interest by enabling small and medium businesses in Nebraska to obtain long distance services at rates that previously were

available only to larger businesses. Applicant will introduce new products and services at very competitive rates.

Interexchange reseller applications are subject to Commission jurisdiction under Neb. Rev. Stat. §§ 86-128 and 86-129 and Title 291 of the Commission's Rules and Regulations, Chapter 5, Rule 003.12. From examination of the application filed herein, the Commission finds that Applicant has provided all the information required by the Commission, possesses adequate financial resources to provide the proposed service and adequate technical competency to provide the proposed service. The application should be granted.

ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that Application C-3413 be, and hereby is, granted and Pacific Centrex Services, Inc., is authorized to operate as a reseller of interexchange telecommunications services within the State of Nebraska in the requested service territories.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the applicant shall file, accordance with the applicable statutes on or before April 30th of each year, an annual report with this Commission consisting report filed with the сору of any Communications Commission; (b) a copy of any annual report to stockholders; and (c) a copy of the latest Form 10-K filed with the Securities and Exchange Commission. If these are not available, applicant shall submit a balance sheet and income statement for the previous year of operation, as well as the investment made in telephone plant and equipment located within the state, accumulated depreciation thereon, operating revenues and expenses and taxes.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that, to the extent applicable, the applicant shall comply with all laws pertaining to, and all rules and regulations promulgated under, the Telecommunications Relay System Act (Neb. Rev. Stat. §§ 86-301 to 86-315) and the Nebraska Telecommunications Universal Service Fund Act (Neb. Rev. Stat. §§ 86-316 to 86-329).

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that applicant file its current tariff, along with the appropriate fee, prior to offering service pursuant to the certificate granted in this order.

IT IS FINALLY ORDERED that this order be, and it is hereby made, the Commission's official certificate of authority to furnish the service authorized herein as a common carrier.
