O P I N I O N A N D F I N D I N G S

On September 7, 2007, the United States District Court for the District of Nebraska reversed the Commission's decision in Docket C-3429 adopting Southeast Nebraska Telephone Company's (SENTCO's) language in an arbitrated Interconnection Agreement and remanded the case to the Commission with instructions to adopt the language provided by Sprint that will define the terms "end users" (or "end use customer") and "reciprocal compensation."¹ In accordance with the District Court's Order, the language proposed by Sprint Communications Company L.P. (Sprint) should be adopted. The Interconnection Agreement filed by Sprint on October 17, 2007, should be approved.

O R D E R

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that the Commission's Orders entered on September 13, 2005, and November 22, 2005, making findings and approving the arbitrated Interconnection Agreement between Sprint and Southeast Nebraska Telephone Company are hereby vacated as mandated by the United States District Court for the District of Nebraska.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that language provided by Sprint Communications L.P. in the arbitration defining the terms "end users" (or "end use customer") and "reciprocal compensation" shall be and it is hereby adopted.
