BY THE COMMISSION:

By application filed May 31, 2005, WWC License, L.L.C., d/b/a GCC License Corporation (WWC) of Bellevue Washington seeks to withdraw its authority to provide resold interexchange telecommunications services previously granted in Application No. C-2000. Notice of the application was published in The Daily Record, Omaha, Nebraska, on June 9, 2005. No protests were filed; therefore, this application is processed pursuant to the Commission's Rule of Modified Procedure.

OPINION AND FINDINGS

WWC was authorized by this Commission to provide resold interexchange telecommunications service in Nebraska on March 3, 1999, pursuant to Application No. C-2000.

On May 31, 2005, WWC requested that their authority to provide resold interexchange telecommunications service in Nebraska be withdrawn. WWC has no pending departmental, formal or informal complaints with the Commission.

Upon consideration of the request and being fully advised, the Commission finds the request to be reasonable and finds that WWC may withdraw its resold telecommunications service authority issued to it by the certificate granted in Application No. C-2000.

ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that Application No. C-3432 be, and it is hereby, granted and the certificate and authority to provide resold telecommunications services granted to WWC License, L.L.C., d/b/a GCC License Corporation are withdrawn.
