O P I N I O N     A N D     F I N D I N G S

By application filed June 6, 2005, NOW Communications, Inc., (NOW), Winter Park, Florida, seeks to discontinue interexchange and local exchange telecommunications services in the state of Nebraska. Notice of the application appeared in The Daily Record on June 14, 2005.

Pursuant to Applications C-2230 and C-2712, NOW was granted authority to operate as a local exchange carrier and an interexchange carrier of telecommunications services in Nebraska. As NOW has no customers in Nebraska, the proposed discontinuance of service will not affect the provision of long distance service in any of those geographic areas.

Upon review of the application and circumstances presented, the Commission is of the opinion that NOW's request should be honored and its certificate should be cancelled.

O R D E R

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that Application C-3436 be, and is hereby granted and the Certificate of Operating Authority previously issued in Application C-2230 and C-2712 be cancelled.
