O P I N I O N      A N D      F I N D I N G S

By letter filed on July 28, 2005, Eclipse Communications Corporation (Eclipse) of Isaquah, Washington, seeks to withdraw its Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity issued by the Commission in Docket C-1760 on June 9, 1998. The Commission, in Docket C-1760 granted Eclipse the authority to provide local exchange service, both on a resale basis and facilities basis in the territories served by US West Communications, Inc. (now Qwest), GTE Midwest, Inc. (now Citizens) and Aliant Communications Company (now ALLTEL). Notice of this application was published in the Daily Record, Omaha, Nebraska on August 3, 2005. No protests were filed; therefore, this Application is processed in accordance with the Commission's Rule of Modified Procedure.

Upon consideration of this application the Commission finds the request made by Eclipse to withdraw its certificate issued in Docket C-1760 should be granted.

O R D E R

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that the application of Eclipse Communications Corporation shall be and it is hereby granted and the Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity issued by the Commission in Docket C-1760 is hereby cancelled.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that any tariffs filed by Eclipse Communications Corporation pursuant to its authority in C-1760 shall be considered withdrawn.
