OPINION AND FINDINGS

The Commission previously assigned "211" to United Way of the Midlands in Applications C-2621/PI-53, entered on February 20, 2002; C-2732, entered on July 23, 2002; C-3061/PI-75, entered on February 10, 2004; C-3099/PI-77, entered on March 30, 2004; C-3223/PI 81, entered on September 21, 2004; C-3277/PI 88, entered on February 1, 2005; C-3327/PI-90, entered on March 22, 2005; C-3344/PI-92, entered on March 29, 2005; and C-3403/PI-95, entered on May 13, 2005 for use in numerous counties throughout the state.

First Call for Help, a program of the United Way of the Midlands Volunteer Resource Center, is a comprehensive information and referral service.

In order to proceed on this request, this docket will evaluate the public benefits of designating "211" for Thayer County. The Commission will hold a hearing on this matter on a date later to be determined.
