OPINION AND FINDINGS

By application filed September 6, 2005, Teleglobe America, Inc., (Teleglobe), Reston, Virginia, seeks to cancel its Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity within the state of Nebraska. Notice of the application appeared in The Daily Record on September 8, 2005.

Pursuant to Application C-3004, Teleglobe was granted authority to provide interexchange telecommunications services in Nebraska. Since Teleglobe does not provide any telecommunications services in Nebraska, no customers will be affected by the cancellation of Teleglobe's certificate.
