O P I N I O N A N D F I N D I N G S

On October 17, 2005, United Telephone Company of the West d/b/a Sprint (Sprint), Overland Park, Kansas, filed an application seeking approval of an amendment to the master interconnection, collocation and resale agreement with Action Communications, Inc. (Action), Scottsbluff, previously granted in Docket C-3333. Notice of the application was published in The Daily Record, Omaha, Nebraska, on October 20, 2005. No protests were filed; therefore, this application is processed pursuant to the Commission's Rule of Modified Procedure.

Pursuant to Section 252(i) of the Telecommunications Act of 1996 (the Act), Sprint and Action entered into an interconnection agreement, which was approved by the Commission on March 22, 2005, in Application C-3333. In the current application, Sprint and Action seek to amend their interconnection agreement. An executed copy of the amendment is contained within the application.

The amendment does not discriminate against any telecommunications carrier. Furthermore, the implementation of the amendment is consistent with the public interest, convenience and necessity.

Section 252(e) of the Act requires this Commission to review negotiated interconnection agreements to ensure they comply with Sections 251 and 252(d) of the Act, as well as all applicable state laws. Using those standards, the amendment filed October 17, 2005, should be approved.

O R D E R

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that the amendment to the interconnection agreement between United Telephone Company of the West d/b/a Sprint, Overland Park, Kansas, and Action Communications, Inc., Scottsbluff, be, and it is hereby, approved.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the executed amendment filed herein be, and it is hereby, made the official copy on file with the Nebraska Public Service Commission.
