OPINION AND FINDINGS

By application filed January 3, 2006, American Farm Bureau, Inc. (AFBI), Park Bridge, Illinois, seeks to withdraw its Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity as a reseller of interexchange telecommunications services in the state of Nebraska previously granted in C-1506. Notice of the application appeared in The Daily Record on January 9, 2006. No protests or interventions were filed; therefore, this application is being processed in accordance with the Commission's rule of Modified Procedure.

In Application No. C-1506, AFBI was granted authority to operate as a reseller of interexchange telecommunications services in Nebraska. AFBI seeks to cancel its authority granted to it in Application No. C-1506. As AFBI has no customers in Nebraska, the proposed discontinuance of service will not affect the provision of long distance service in any of those geographic areas.

Upon review of the application and circumstances presented, the Commission is of the opinion that AFBI's request should be honored and its certificate should be canceled.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that Application No. C-3532 be, and it is hereby, granted and the certificate of operating authority previously issued in Application No. C-1506 be canceled.
