OPINION AND FINDINGS

On February 24, 2006, Qwest Corporation ("Qwest") of Denver, Colorado, filed an application seeking a Digital Subscriber Line amendment to the interconnection agreement New Edge Networks ("New Edge"), of Vancouver, Washington. original The agreement was approved Application No. C-2799. Notice of the application was published in The Daily Record, Omaha, Nebraska, on March 3, 2006. No protests were filed; therefore, this application is processed pursuant to the Commission's Rule of Modified Procedure.

On October 8, 2002, in Application No. C-2799, the original interconnection agreement between Qwest and New Edge was approved by this Commission. In the current application, Qwest seeks to amend the agreement by adding a Digital Subscriber Line amendment to the interconnection agreement. An executed copy of the amendment is contained within the application.

The amendment does not discriminate against any telecommunications carrier. Furthermore, the implementation of the amendment is consistent with the public interest, convenience and necessity.

Section 252(e) of the Act requires this Commission to review negotiated interconnection agreements to ensure they comply with Sections 251 and 252(d) of the Act, as well as all applicable state laws. Using those standards, the amendment filed February 24, 2006, should be approved.

ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that the amendment to the interconnection agreement between Qwest Corporation and New Edge Networks, be, and it is hereby, approved.
