OPINION AND FINDINGS

By application filed April 25, 2006, ICG Telecom Group, Inc. (ICG) of Englewood, Colorado, seeks to withdraw its Certificates of Public Convenience and Necessity to provide local exchange and interexchange telecommunications services within the state of Nebraska. Notice of the application appeared in The Daily Record on April 26, 2006. No protests were filed; therefore, this application is processed pursuant to the Commission's Rule of Modified Procedure.

Pursuant to Docket Nos. C-1818 and C-2684, ICG was granted authority to operate as an interexchange carrier and a local exchange carrier of telecommunications services in Nebraska. Currently, ICG does not offer any telecommunications services in Nebraska. ICG requests Commission approval to withdraw its certificates of public convenience and necessity and to cancel all related tariffs.

Upon review of the application and circumstances presented, the Commission is of the opinion that ICG's request should be honored. ICG's certificates should be withdrawn and all related tariffs should be canceled.

ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that application C-3586 be and it is hereby granted and the certificates of operating authority previously issued in Application Nos. C-1818 and C-2687 are hereby withdrawn.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that ICG Telecom Group Inc.'s related tariff(s) filed with the Nebraska Public Service Commission be and is hereby canceled.
