On May 15, 2006, an application was filed by ITC^DeltaCom Communications, Inc. ("Applicant") of Huntsville, Alabama, seeking a name change to DeltaCom, Inc. Notice of the application was published in The Daily Record, Omaha, Nebraska, on May 17, 2006. No protests were filed; therefore, we process this application pursuant to the Commission's Rule of Modified Procedure.

O P I N I O N A N D F I N D I N G S

Applicant is a corporation created and existing under the laws of the state of Alabama, with its principal office located at 7037 Old Madison Pike, Huntsville, Alabama. Applicant provides international and domestic interstate, intrastate and local telecommunications. The applicant was granted authority by this Commission to operate as a resale carrier of intrastate interexchange interLATA and intraLATA telecommunications services under Application No. C-1436.

In the present application, Applicant seeks authorization to change its name to DeltaCom, Inc. ITC^DeltaCom Communications, Inc. has received authority from the Secretary of State of Nebraska to change its corporate name. The name change will have no impact on customers or services. Customers will be provided notice of the name change via written communications.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that Application No. C-3596 be, and it is hereby, granted and ITC^DeltaCom Communications, Inc. is authorized to do business as DeltaCom, Inc.
