BY THE COMMISSION:

By application filed May 15, 2006, Qwest Corporation (Qwest) of Denver, Colorado, seeks approval of an interconnection agreement with Pacific Centrex Services Inc. (Pacific), of North Hollywood, California, pursuant to section 252(i) of the Telecommunications Act of 1996 (the Act). Notice of the application was published in The Daily Record, Omaha, Nebraska, on May 19, 2006. No protests were filed; therefore, this application is processed pursuant to the Commission's Rule of Modified Procedure.

Section 252(i) of the Act allows any telecommunications carrier to adopt a Commission-approved interconnection Pacific and Owest wish to establish agreement. interconnection agreement and accordingly request approval to adopt the interconnection agreement previously approved by the Commission in Application No. C-3284 entered into by Long Distance, f/k/a SBC Inc. Southwestern Communications Services and Owest Corporation. copy of the agreement is contained within the application.

On May 28, 1997, the Commission added language to its mediation/arbitration policy (see Application No. C-1128, Progression Order No. 3) which sets forth the procedures to be followed for a Section 252(i) request. Qwest and Pacific have complied with the Commission's Policy.

Neither the nor portion agreement any thereof discriminates telecommunications carrier. against any the implementation of Furthermore, the agreement consistent with the public interest, convenience necessity. Using those standards, the interconnection agreement should be approved.

ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that the interconnection agreement between Qwest Communications, Denver, Colorado, and Pacific Centrex Services, Inc., be, and it is hereby, approved.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the adoption of the SBC Long Distance, Inc. f/k/a Southwestern Bell Communications Services and Qwest Corporation agreement by Qwest and Pacific Centrex Services, Inc. became effective May 29, 2006.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the executed interconnection agreement filed herein be, and it is hereby, made the official copy on file with the Nebraska Public Service Commission.
