BY THE COMMISSION:

By application filed May 22, 2006, Qwest Corporation (Qwest) of Denver, Colorado, seeks approval of a Triennial Review Order and Triennial Review Remand Order (TRO/TRRO) amendment to an interconnection agreement with ACN Communications Services Inc. (ACN) of Farmington Hills, Michigan. Notice of the application was published in The Daily Record, Omaha, Nebraska, on May 25, 2006. No protests were filed; therefore, this application is processed pursuant to the Commission's Rule of Modified Procedure.

Pursuant to Section 252(a) of the Telecommunications Act of 1996 (the Act), Qwest and ACN entered into an amendment to their interconnection agreement. The amendment incorporates the Federal Communications Commission's Triennial Review Order ("TRO") and Triennial Review Remand Order ("TRRO") into the interconnection agreement which was previously approved by the Commission in Application No. C-3203. An executed copy of this amendment is contained within the application.

Neither the agreement nor any portion thereof discriminates against any telecommunications carrier. Furthermore, the implementation of the agreement is consistent with the public interest, convenience and necessity.

Section 252(e) of the Act requires this Commission to review interconnection agreements to ensure they comply with Sections 251 and 252(d) of the Act, as well as all applicable state laws. Using those standards, the interconnection agreement should be approved.

O R D E R

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that the amendment between Qwest Communications, Denver, Colorado, and ACN Communications Services, Inc. be, and it is hereby, approved.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the executed amendment filed herein be, and it is hereby, made the official copy on file with the Nebraska Public Service Commission.
