By application filed June 19, 2006, Qwest Corporation (Owest), Denver, Colorado, seeks approval of its wireline interconnection agreement with Ymax Communications Corp. a/k/a Palm Beach Telephone Company (Ymax), Palm Beach, Notice of the application was published in the Florida. Daily Record, Omaha, Nebraska, on June 22, 2006. protests were filed; therefore, this application is processed pursuant to the Commission's Rule of Modified Procedure.

Pursuant to Section 252(a) of the Telecommunications Act of 1996 (the Act), Qwest and Ymax entered into an interconnection service agreement arrived at through voluntary negotiations. An executed copy of this agreement is contained within the application.

Neither the agreement nor any portion discriminates against any telecommunications carrier. Furthermore, the implementation of the agreement is consistent with the public interest, convenience and necessity.

Section 252(e) of the Act requires this Commission to review interconnection agreements adopted by negotiation or arbitration to ensure they comply with Sections 251 and 252(d) of the Act, as well as all applicable state laws. Using those standards, the interconnection agreement should be approved.
