O P I N I O N     A N D     F I N D I N G S

On July 3, 2006, Qwest Corporation ("Qwest") of Denver, Colorado, filed an application seeking approval of its Triennial Review Order and Triennial Review Remand Order amendment with AT&T Communications of the Midwest, Inc. (AT&T), Denver, Colorado. This agreement amends the interconnection agreement previously approved in Application No. C-3095. Notice of the application was published in The Daily Record, Omaha, Nebraska, on July 13, 2006. No protests were filed; therefore, this application is processed pursuant to the Commission's Rule of Modified Procedure.

On October 13, 2004, in Application No. C-3095, the original interconnection agreement between Qwest and AT&T was approved by the Commission. In the current application, Qwest seeks to amend the agreement by adding a Triennial Review Order and Triennial Review Remand Order amendment to the interconnection agreement. An executed copy of the amendment is contained within the application.

The amendment does not discriminate against any telecommunications carrier. Furthermore, the implementation of the amendment is consistent with the public interest, convenience and necessity.

Section 252(e) of the Act requires this Commission to review negotiated interconnection agreements to ensure they comply with Sections 251 and 252(d) of the Act, as well as

all applicable state laws. Using those standards, the amendment filed July 3, 2006, should be approved.

O R D E R

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that the amendment to the interconnection agreement between Qwest Corporation and AT&T Communications of the Midwest, Inc., be, and it is hereby, approved.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the executed amendment filed herein be, and it is hereby, made the official copy on file with the Nebraska Public Service Commission.
