BY THE COMMISSION:

By application filed July 19, 2006, Qwest Corporation (Qwest) of Denver, Colorado, seeks approval of its Wireless Type 2 Agreement with Long Lines Wireless, LLC (Long Lines), of Spencer, Iowa. Notice of the application was published in The Daily Record, Omaha, Nebraska, on July 21, 2006. No protests were filed; therefore, this application is processed pursuant to the Commission's Rule of Modified Procedure.

Pursuant to Section 252(a) of the Telecommunications Act of 1996 (the Act), Qwest and Long Lines entered into a Wireless Type 2 Agreement arrived at through voluntary negotiations. An executed copy of this agreement is contained within the application.

Neither the agreement nor any portion thereof discriminates against any telecommunications carrier. Furthermore, the implementation of the agreement is consistent with the public interest, convenience and necessity.

Section 252(e) of the Act requires this Commission to review interconnection agreements adopted by negotiation or arbitration to ensure they comply with Sections 251 and 252(d) of the Act, as well as all applicable state laws. Using those standards, the interconnection agreement should be approved.

O R D E R

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that the Wireless Type 2 Agreement between Qwest Communications, Denver, Colorado, and Long Lines Wireless, LLC be, and it is hereby, approved.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the executed interconnection agreement filed herein be, and it is hereby, made the official copy on file with the Nebraska Public Service Commission.
