O P I N I O N A N D F I N D I N G S

On August 7, 2006, Qwest Corporation (Qwest) of Denver, Colorado, filed an application seeking approval of its Triennial Review Order and Triennial Review Remand Order amendment with Nebraska Technology and Telecommunications, Inc., (NT&T) of Omaha. This agreement amends the interconnection agreement previously approved in Application No. C-1752. Notice of the application was published in The Daily Record, Omaha, Nebraska, on August 10, 2006. No protests were filed; therefore, this application is processed pursuant to the Commission's Rule of Modified Procedure.

On February 18, 1998, in Application No. C-1752, the original interconnection agreement between Qwest and NT&T was approved by the Commission. In the current application, Qwest seeks to amend the agreement by adding a Triennial Review Order and Triennial Review Remand Order amendment to the interconnection agreement. An executed copy of the amendment is contained within the application.

The amendment does not discriminate against any telecommunications carrier. Furthermore, the implementation of the amendment is consistent with the public interest, convenience and necessity.

Section 252(e) of the Act requires this Commission to review negotiated interconnection agreements to ensure they comply with Sections 251 and 252(d) of the Act, as well as all applicable state laws. Using those standards, the amendment filed August 7, 2006, should be approved.

O R D E R

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that the amendment to the interconnection agreement between Qwest Corporation and Nebraska Technology and Telecommunications, Inc., be, and it is hereby, approved.
