BY THE COMMISSION:

On October 26, 2006, an application was filed by United Telecom, Inc. (United/Applicant) of Los Angeles, California, seeking authority to operate as an interexchange carrier of telecommunications services within the State of Nebraska. Notice of the application was published in The Daily Record, Omaha, Nebraska, on October 30, 2006. No protests were filed; therefore, this application is processed pursuant to the Commission's rules of modified procedure.

O P I N I O N     A N D     F I N D I N G S

United is a California corporation with its headquarters in Los Angeles. United has been authorized by the Secretary of State to operate in Nebraska as a foreign corporation. In addition, no officer, director or shareholder having five percent or more of the applicant's voting securities has been involved in a formal complaint or other investigatory or enforcement proceeding.

United is a switchless, non-facilities based interexchange resale carrier providing telecommunications services to residential customers. United proposes to offer these services throughout the State of Nebraska. All network services are supplied through major interexchange carriers through which United contracts for services. From time to time, United may offer other services provided by other wholesale long distance carriers. United does not propose to provide alternative operator services and will not require deposits.

Interexchange applications are subject to Commission jurisdiction under Neb. Rev. Stat. § 86-129 and Title 291 of the Commission's Rules and Regulations, Chapter 5, Rule 003.12. From examination of the application filed herein, the Commission finds United has provided all the information required by the Commission, possesses adequate financial resources to provide

the proposed service, and possesses adequate technical competency to provide the proposed service. Applicant has demonstrated that a grant of this application would serve public interest. The application should be granted.

O R D E R

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that Application No. C-3714 be, and it is hereby, granted and United Telecom, Inc., is authorized to operate as an interexchange carrier of telecommunications services within the state of Nebraska.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the applicant shall file, in accordance with the applicable statutes on or before April 30th of each year, an annual report with this Commission consisting of: (a) a copy of any report filed with the Federal Communications Commission; (b) a copy of any annual report to stockholders; and (c) a copy of the latest Form 10-K filed with the Securities and Exchange Commission. If these are not available, applicant shall submit a balance sheet and income statement for the previous year of operation, as well as the investment made in telephone plant and equipment located within the state, accumulated depreciation thereon, operating revenues and expenses, and taxes.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that, to the extent applicable, the applicant shall comply with all laws pertaining to, and all rules and regulations promulgated under, the Telecommunications Relay System Act (Neb. Rev. Stat. §§ 86-301 to 86-315) and the Nebraska Telecommunications Universal Service Fund Act (Neb. Rev. Stat. §§ 86-316 to 86-329).

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that applicant file its current tariff prior to offering service pursuant to the certificate granted in this order.

IT IS FINALLY ORDERED that this order be, and it is hereby made, the Commission's official certificate of authority to furnish the service authorized herein as a common carrier.
