O P I N I O N     A N D     F I N D I N G S

On December 15, 2006, an application was filed by Alltel Communications of Nebraska, Inc., of Little Rock, Arkansas, seeking expansion of Eligible Telecommunications Carrier Designation pursuant to section 214(e)(2) of the Communications Act of 1934. A Petition of Formal Intervention was filed by the Rural Independent Companies on December 21, 2006. On February 22, 2007, the Petition of Intervention was withdrawn. On February 27, 2007, the Commission granted the application and designated Alltel as an Eligible Telecommunications Carrier (ETC) for the wire centers and rural telephone company service areas set forth in attachments labeled as Appendix A and B to the Commission's Order.

Alltel subsequently notified the Commission that it omitted one wire center, Long Pine, from the attachment to the application and consequently that wire center was not listed in Attachment B to the Commission's Designation Order of February 27, 2007. However, Alltel in its application requested ETC designation for the remainder of the State of Nebraska. Accordingly, the application was sufficient in specifying the ETC designation area and the Commission's intent in the Order issued on February 27, 2007, was to grant that request. This Order Nunc Pro Tunc is issued to correct the record and include the wire center description which was absent from the Attachment B to the Commission's February 27, 2007 Order.

The purpose of a nunc pro tunc is to correct the record which has been made so that it will truly record the action taken which, through inadvertence or mistake, was not truly recorded. Interstate Printing Co. v. Dept. of Revenue, 236 Neb. 110, 459 N.W.2d 519 (1990). Clerical errors may be corrected by an order nunc pro tunc, but not judicial errors. Larson v. Bedke, 211 Neb. 247, 318 N.W.2d 253 (1982).

After examining the record and being fully advised, the Commission finds that the February 27, 2007 Order in Application No. C-3739 omitted the following description:

The Commission enters this Order Nunc Pro Tunc to correct the original Order.

O R D E R

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that its February 27, 2007 Order be corrected to include the wire center for Long Pine as described above.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Alltel shall file a copy of this Order with the Universal Service Administrative Company (USAC) and the FCC to commence its receipt of federal universal service support.
