## BY THE COMMISSION:

On January 24, 2007, an application was filed by Qwest Corporation, (Qwest), Denver, Colorado, seeking approval of a Negotiated Wireline Interconnection Agreement which is considered by the Commission as an Extended Area Service Agreement between Qwest and Long Lines Metro, L.L.C., Sergeant Bluff, Iowa. Notice of the application was published in The Daily Record, Omaha, Nebraska, on January 29, 2007. No protests were filed; therefore, this application is processed pursuant to the Commission's Rule of Modified Procedure.

Long Lines Metro and Qwest entered into an Extended Area Service Agreement arrived at through voluntary negotiations. The agreement establishes that Long Lines Metro is a competitive local exchange carrier operating in Missouri Valley, Iowa. Qwest offers their customers in Missouri Valley, Iowa, extended area service to and from Omaha, Nebraska. Long Lines Metro is not a certified competitive local exchange carrier in Nebraska and will not have end users in Nebraska. The intent of the agreement is to allow Long Lines Metro subscribers in Missouri Valley, Iowa, to have the same extended area service calling area offered to Qwest subscribers. An executed copy of this agreement is contained within the application.

Neither the agreement nor any portion thereof discriminates against any telecommunications carrier. Furthermore, the implementation of the agreement is consistent with public interest, convenience and necessity.

The Commission has reviewed the Extended Area Service Agreement to ensure it complies with applicable state laws. Using those standards, the Extended Area Service Agreement should be approved.

## ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that the Extended Area Service Agreement between Long Lines Metro, LLC and Qwest Corporation be, and it is hereby, approved.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the executed Extended Area Service Agreement filed herein be, and it is hereby, made the official copy on file with the Nebraska Public Service Commission.
