BY THE COMMISSION:

Due to time constraints, Cox Nebraska Telcom, LLC ("Cox") and Qwest Corporation ("Qwest"), in consultation with Commission Staff, have agreed to an extension of time to file the Arbitrated Interconnection Agreement ("Agreement") between Cox and Qwest required pursuant to the Commission's Mediation and Arbitration Policy established in Docket C-1128, Progression Order No. 3.

The Arbitrator's decision was filed with the Commission on November 13, 2007. The Agreement based upon that decision was due to be filed with the Commission on or before December 13, 2007. Comments by interested parties would then be due to the Commission on December 24, 2007. Due to the holidays and other time constraints, the parties have agreed that an extension of the deadline to file the Arbitrated Interconnection Agreement to January 4, 2008, is in the best interest of all parties. The parties further agree that an extension will give them an opportunity to fully examine and verify the Agreement and ensure that it is consistent with the recommendations of the Arbitrator and such an extension will not prejudice any party.

Upon full consideration of the facts and circumstances, the Commission finds that an extension of the deadline for filing of the Agreement should be granted.

O R D E R

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that an extension of time to file the Arbitrated Agreement shall be granted and that the parties shall file the Arbitrated Interconnection Agreement with the Commission no later than 5:00 p.m., on January 4, 2008.
