BY THE COMMISSION:

By application filed April 25, 2007, Qwest Corporation ("Qwest") of Denver, Colorado, seeks approval of a New Negotiated Wireline Interconnection Agreement with Unite Private Networks, LLC, ("Unite") of Kansas City, Missouri. Notice of the application was published in The Daily Record, Omaha, Nebraska, on April 27, 2007. No protests were filed; therefore, this application is processed pursuant to the Commission's Rule of Modified Procedure.

Pursuant to Section 252(a) of the Telecommunications Act of 1996 (the Act), Qwest and Unite entered into a New Negotiated Wireline Interconnection Agreement using Qwest's Statement of Generally Available Terms (SGAT). An executed copy of this agreement is contained within the application.

Neither the agreement nor any portion thereof discriminates against any telecommunications carrier. Furthermore, the implementation of the agreement is consistent with the public interest, convenience and necessity.

Section 252(f) of the Act requires this Commission to review interconnection agreements adopted pursuant to SGAT to ensure they comply with Sections 251 and 252(d) of the Act, as well as all applicable state laws. Using those standards, the interconnection agreement should be approved.

ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that the New Negotiated Wireline Interconnection Agreement between Qwest Communications, Denver, Colorado, and Unite Private Networks, LLC., Kansas City, Missouri, be, and it is hereby, approved.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the executed interconnection agreement filed herein be, and it is hereby, made the official copy on file with the Nebraska Public Service Commission.
