## BY THE COMMISSION:

By application filed May 29, 2007, Qwest Corporation, (Qwest), Denver, Colorado, sought approval of a Business Escalation Agreement with Verizon Business Network Services, Inc. (Verizon) and its affiliates MCI Communications Services, Inc. and MCImetro Access Transmission Services, LLC, Ashburn, Virginia. Notice of the application was published in <a href="The Daily Record">The Daily Record</a>, Omaha, Nebraska, on June 4, 2007. No protests or interventions were filed.

## OPINION AND FINDINGS

By letter filed on July 3, 2007, Qwest requested to withdraw its application for Commission approval of this Business Escalation Agreement (Agreement). Qwest filed the agreement on the belief that the escalation procedures applied to the services provided under interconnection agreements between the parties. After filing the Agreement it became known to Qwest that the intended scope of the Agreement was not to cover such interconnection services.

Upon consideration of Qwest's statements, the Commission is of the opinion and finds the application for approval of the Business Escalation Agreement should be considered withdrawn.

## ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that the above-captioned application be and it is hereby withdrawn at Applicant's request.
