BY THE COMMISSION:

By application filed June 5, 2007, Smartstop, Inc. (Smartstop), of Portland, Oregon, seeks to withdraw its authority to offer interexchange telecommunications services and to cancel its tariffs in the State of Nebraska. Notice of the application was published in The Daily Record, Omaha, Nebraska, on June 7, 2007. No protests were filed; therefore, this application is processed pursuant to the Commission's Rule of Modified Procedure.

O P I N I O N A N D F I N D I N G S

Pursuant to the authority granted by the Commission in Docket C-1762, Smartstop. was given the ability to offer interexchange telecommunications services within the State of Nebraska. By letter received on June 5, 2007, Smartstop requested the withdrawal of its Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity and Tariffs within the State of Nebraska. Smartstop no longer has customers in Nebraska and does not intend to resell its telecommunications services in Nebraska.

Upon consideration of the request and being fully advised in the premises, the Commission finds the request to be reasonable and finds that Smartstop's Certificates of Public Convenience and Necessity to offer telecommunications services and all applicable tariffs should be cancelled.

O R D E R

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that Application No. C-3816 be, and it is hereby, granted and the Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity granted to Smartstop, Inc., to offer telecommunications service in the State of Nebraska and all applicable tariffs are cancelled.
