BY THE COMMISSION:

By application filed July 24, 2007, Infonet Telecommunications Corporation, (Infonet) El Segundo, California, is seeking authority to withdraw its certificate of authority to provide interexchange telecommunications services in the State of Nebraska, previously approved in Docket C-2690. Notice of the application was published in The Daily Record, Omaha, Nebraska, on August 30, 2007. No protests were filed; therefore, this application is processed pursuant to the Commission's Rule of Modified Procedure.

OPINION AND FINDINGS

On April 9, 2002, Infonet was granted authority to operate as an interexchange telecommunications carrier within the State of Nebraska pursuant to Docket C-2690.

By application received on July 24, 2007, Infonet requested the cancellation of its authority to operate as an interexchange carrier of telecommunications services in the State of Nebraska and the withdrawal of its Tariff. Infonet has no customers or operations in Nebraska.

Upon consideration of the request and being fully advised, the Commission finds the request to be reasonable and finds that Infonet's authority to operate as an interexchange carrier of telecommunications services in the State of Nebraska should be cancelled.

ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that Application No. C-3844 be, and it is hereby, granted and the Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity to provide interexchange telecommunications services previously granted to Infonet Telecommunications Corporation is cancelled.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Infonet Telecommunications Corporation's Interexchange Tariff, be, and is hereby, withdrawn.
