BY THE COMMISSION:

By application filed August 6, 2007, Nebraska Technology & Telecommunications, Inc., (NT&T), sought Arbitration of an Interconnection Agreement with Windstream Nebraska, Inc., (Windstream), Lincoln, pursuant to section 252 of the Telecommunications Act of 1996. Notice of the application was originally published in the Daily Record, Omaha, Nebraska, on August 30, Subsequently, NT&Tand Windstream reached Interconnection Agreement arrived at through voluntary negotiations. The Commission published notice of interconnection agreement in the Daily Record on October 15, 2007. No protests or interventions were filed; Commission processes therefore, the this voluntarily negotiated interconnection agreement pursuant to its Rule of Modified Procedure.

Pursuant to Section 252(a) of the Telecommunications Act of 1996 (the Act), NT&T and Windstream ("parties") entered into an Interconnection Agreement arrived at through voluntary negotiations. An executed copy of this agreement is contained within the application.

Neither the agreement nor any portion thereof against discriminates any telecommunications carrier. Furthermore, the implementation of the agreement consistent with the public interest, convenience and necessity.

Section 252(e) of the Act requires this Commission to review interconnection agreements adopted by negotiation or arbitration to ensure they comply with Sections 251 and 252(d) of the Act, as well as all applicable state laws.

Using those standards, the Interconnection Agreement should be approved.

ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that the Interconnection Agreement between NT&T and Windstream shall be, and it is hereby, approved.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the executed interconnection agreement filed herein be, and it is hereby, made the official copy on file with the Nebraska Public Service Commission.
