OPINION AND FINDINGS

On August 20, 2007, Qwest Corporation (Qwest), Denver, Colorado, filed an application seeking approval of its Triennial Review Order and Triennial Review Remand Order Amendment to the interconnection agreement with Granite Telecommunications, LLC, (Granite), Quincy, Massachusetts, previously approved in Docket C-3054. Notice of the application was published in The Daily Record, Omaha, Nebraska, on August 23, 2007. No protests were filed; therefore, this application is processed pursuant to the Commission's Rule of Modified Procedure.

On January 13, 2004, in Docket C-3054, the original interconnection agreement between Qwest and Granite was approved by this Commission. In the current application, Qwest seeks to amend the agreement by adding a Triennial Review Order and Triennial Review Remand Order Amendment to the interconnection agreement. An executed copy of the amendment is contained within the application.

The amendment does not discriminate against any telecommunications carrier. Furthermore, the implementation of the amendment is consistent with the public interest, convenience and necessity.

Section 252(e) of the Act requires this Commission to review negotiated interconnection agreements to ensure they comply with Sections 251 and 252(d) of the Act, as well as

all applicable state laws. Using those standards, the amendment filed August 20, 2007, should be approved.

ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that the amendment to the interconnection agreement between Qwest Corporation and Granite Telecommunications, LLC, be, and it is hereby, approved.
