## BY THE COMMISSION:

By application filed August 27, 2007, Total Communications, Inc., (Total) Lincoln, is seeking authority to withdraw its certificate of authority to provide interexchange telecommunications services in the State of Nebraska, previously in Docket C-2258. Notice of the application published in The Daily Record, Omaha, Nebraska, on August 31, No protests were filed; therefore, this application is pursuant to the Commission's Rule of processed Modified Procedure.

## OPINION AND FINDINGS

On July 11, 2000, Total was granted authority to operate as an interexchange telecommunications carrier within the State of Nebraska pursuant to Docket C-2258.

By application received on August 27, 2007, Total requested the cancellation of its authority to operate as an interexchange carrier of telecommunications services in the State of Nebraska and the withdrawal of its Tariff. Total is a wholly owned subsidiary of Curtis Telephone Company (Curtis). Curtis was acquired by Consolidated Companies in March 2007. As a result of the acquisition, Total no longer exists and has no customers or operations in Nebraska.

Upon consideration of the request and being fully advised, the Commission finds the request to be reasonable and finds that Total's authority to operate as an interexchange carrier of telecommunications services in the State of Nebraska should be cancelled.

## ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that Application No. C-3854 be, and it is hereby, granted and the Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity to provide interexchange telecommunications services previously granted to Total Communications, Inc., is cancelled.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Total Communications, Inc.'s Interexchange Tariff, be, and is hereby, withdrawn.
