OPINION AND FINDINGS

On November 5, 2007, an application was filed by Qwest Corporation (Qwest), of Denver, Colorado, seeking approval of an Amendment to the Interconnection Agreement with Windstream of the Midwest, Inc. f/k/a ALLTEL Communications of the Midwest, Inc., (Windstream), Little Rock, Arkansas, which was previously approved by the Commission in Docket C-1530. Notice of the application was published in <u>The Daily Record</u>, Omaha, Nebraska, on November 7, 2007. No protests were filed; therefore, this application is processed pursuant to the Commission's Rule of Modified Procedure.

11. 1997, Docket C-1530, the On June in original Interconnection Agreement between Owest and Windstream approved by the Commission. In the current application, Owest amend the agreement by adding a CLEC-to-CLEC Connections Amendment to the Interconnection Agreement. The Amendment does not discriminate against any telecommunications carrier that is not a party to the agreement. Furthermore, the implementation of the Amendment is consistent with the public interest, convenience and necessity.

Section 252(e) of the Act requires this Commission to review negotiated interconnection agreements to ensure they comply with Sections 251 and 252(d) of the Act, as well as all applicable state laws. Using those standards, the Amendment filed November 5, 2007, should be approved.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that the Amendment to the Interconnection Agreement between Qwest Corporation and Windstream of the Midwest, Inc., be, and it is hereby, approved.
