BY THE COMMISSION:

On April 30, 2008, an application was filed by L6-Global, LLC, ("Acquisition Co"), Duluth, Georgia, and Global Connection, Inc. of America, ("Global"), Atlanta, Georgia, (together with Acquisition Co, the "Applicants") seeking approval of a transfer of ownership whereby Acquisition Co will acquire control of Global. Notice of the application was published in The Daily Record, Omaha, Nebraska, on May 5, 2008. No protests were filed; therefore, this application is processed pursuant to the Commission's Rule of Modified Procedure.

OPINION AND FINDINGS

The Parties:

Global is a reseller of residential prepaid telecommunications services with principal offices located in Atlanta, Georgia. Global was certified as a Competitive Local Exchange Provider ("CLEC") in the State of Nebraska and by virtue of authority granted by the Commission on August 24, 2004, under Docket C-3205.

Acquisition Co is a Georgia limited liability company managed by L6 Holding Corporation ("L6") with principal offices in Duluth, Georgia.

Description of the Transaction:

According to the application, L6 established Acquisition Co with the sole purpose of making a controlling investment in Global Connection Holdings Corporation ("Hold Co"). Hold Co will be owned by Acquisition Co (80%) and Sam Abdallah (20%) post closing of the transaction. Holding Co will own 100% of Global post closing.

The Applicants anticipate that the proposed transaction will be seamless and transparent to any customers in Nebraska. The Applicants state that Global will continue to offer service with no change in name, rates or terms and conditions of

service. The Applicants also anticipate additions to the management team and the recruitment of an independent Board of Directors.

The Applicants state that the proposed transaction is in the public interest because the transaction will benefit Global customers by placing Global in a position to expand its service offerings while gaining access to the additional resources and operational expertise of L6.

Based on the evidence, we find the application to be fair and reasonable and in the public interest. The application should be granted.

ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that Application No. C-3929, be, and it is hereby, granted.
