BY THE COMMISSION:

On May 15, 2008, an application was filed by Sprint Long Distance, Inc. ("Sprint") of Overland Park, Kansas, seeking authority to changes its name to Embarq Communications, Inc. Notice of the application was published in The Daily Record, Omaha, Nebraska, on May 16, 2008. No protests were filed; therefore, we process this application pursuant to the Commission's Rule of Modified Procedure.

O P I N I O N A N D F I N D I N G S

Sprint is a corporation with it principal offices located at 5454 West 110th Street, Overland Park, Kansas 66211. Sprint operates pursuant to a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity issued by this Commission on October 18, 2005, under Docket C-3468, and is subject to the jurisdiction of this Commission.

In the present application, Sprint requests that the Commission enter an order approving the adoption by Sprint of the name "Embarq Communications, Inc." Sprint has received authority from the Secretary of State to use the new name. The adoption of the new name will have no effect on the rates, terms or conditions of Sprint's provision of telecommunications services to its customers. Based on the information contained in the application, the Commission is of the opinion and finds the application should be granted.

O R D E R

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that Application No. C-3936 be, and it is hereby, granted and the request of Sprint Long Distance, Inc. to change its name to Embarq Communications, Inc. is approved.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the applicant file an updated tariff reflecting the change in name within 30 days of the date of this order.


