BY THE COMMISSION:

On October 9, 2008, an application was filed by Total Holdings, Inc. d/b/a GTC Communications (GTC or Applicant), Los authority to California, seeking operate interexchange carrier within the State of Nebraska. Notice of the application was published in The Daily Record, No Nebraska, on October 13, 2008. protests were filed; therefore, this application is processed pursuant Commission's rule of modified procedure.

OPINION AND FINDINGS

Applicant is a California corporation with its principal offices in Los Angeles, California. GTC has been authorized by the Secretary of State to operate in Nebraska as a foreign corporation. In addition, no officer, director or shareholder having five percent or more of the applicant's voting securities has been involved in a formal complaint or other investigatory or enforcement proceeding.

Applicant intends to provide interexchange services throughout Nebraska. Applicant states that it will not use owned or leased facilities in Nebraska. Applicant does not intend to provide alternative operator services nor require advanced payments or deposits. Applicant has provided certified financial statements and evidence of financial profitability.

Applicant is a switchless, non-facilities-based reseller of operator services, with telecommunications services provided over the networks of its underlying carrier, Sprint. Therefore, Applicant will be solely dependent on the technical capabilities of its underlying carrier(s). Applicant has filed for or intends to file for certification to provide telecommunications services in 49 states. In no instance has any application been denied or rejected.

Interexchange reseller applications are subject to Commission jurisdiction under Neb. Rev. Stat. §§ 86-128 and 86-129 and Title 291 of the Commission's Rules and Regulations, Chapter 5, Rule 003.12. From examination of the application filed herein, the Commission finds GTC has provided all the information required by the Commission, possesses adequate financial resources to provide the proposed service, and possesses adequate technical competency to provide the proposed service. The application should be granted.

ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that Application No. C-3971 be, and it is hereby, granted and Total Holdings, Inc. d/b/a GTC Communications is authorized to operate as an interexchange carrier of telecommunications services within the State of Nebraska.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the applicant shall file, in accordance with the applicable statutes on or before April 30th of each year, an annual report with this Commission consisting of: (a) a copy of any report filed with the Federal Communications Commission; (b) a copy of any annual report to stockholders; and (c) a copy of the latest Form 10-K filed with the Securities and Exchange Commission. If these are not available, applicant shall submit a balance sheet and income statement for the previous year of operation, as well as the investment made in telephone plant and equipment located within the state, accumulated depreciation thereon, operating revenues and expenses, and taxes.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that, to the extent applicable, the applicant shall comply with all laws pertaining to, and all rules and regulations promulgated under, the Telecommunications Relay System Act ($\underline{\text{Neb. Rev. Stat.}}$ §§ 86-301 to 86-315) and the Nebraska Telecommunications Universal Service Fund Act ($\underline{\text{Neb.}}$ Rev. Stat. §§ 86-316 to 86-329).

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that applicant file its current tariff prior to offering service pursuant to the certificate granted in this order.

IT IS FINALLY ORDERED that this order be, and it is hereby made, the Commission's official certificate of authority to furnish the service authorized herein as a common carrier.
