O P I N I O N     A N D     F I N D I N G S

Huntel is a corporation with its principal offices located at 1605 Washington Street, Blair, Nebraska, 68008.

In the present application, Huntel requests that the Commission enter an order approving the adoption by Huntel of the name "Huntel, Inc. d/b/a American Broadband Nebraska Communications, Inc." Huntel has received authority from the Secretary of State to use the new name. The adoption of the new name will have no effect on the rates, terms or conditions of Huntel's provision of telecommunications services to its customers. Based on the all the evidence adduced, the Commission is of the opinion the application is in the public interest and should be granted.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that Application No. C-4002 be, and it is hereby, granted and the request of Huntel, Inc. to change its name to Huntel, Inc. d/b/a American Broadband Nebraska Communications, Inc. is approved.
