By order entered on March 17, 2009, the Commission opened this docket to adopt a relief plan for the 402 area code. Notice of this proceeding appeared in the $\underline{\text{Daily Record}}$, Omaha, Nebraska, on April 14, 2009.

Comments were solicited by the Commission on a number of alternative area code relief plans. Comments were filed by Qwest Corporation; Cox Nebraska Telcom, LLC; the Rural Independent Companies; Sprint Nextel; AT&T; Verizon Wireless; Verizon Business and CTIA/The Wireless Association. All commenters supported an all-services overlay plan.

A public workshop was held on April 20, 2009, to facilitate the collection of information and opinions on a preferred relief plan. All participants in the workshop supported an all-services overlay plan.

The Commission again requested comments from interested persons and scheduled the issues for public hearing. A public hearing was held in Lincoln, Nebraska, on May 27, 2009. The comments received by the Commission were incorporated into the record.

On June 30, 2009, the Commission entered an order adopting an all-services overlay plan as the official relief plan for the The Commission ordered the industry to file a 402 area code. detailing recommendation milestones for implementing On September 15, 2009, the Commission Commission's Order. entered an order adopting the milestones for implementing the all-services overlay plan. The Commission kept this docket open to monitor that implementation. At this time, the Commission finds no further action is needed in this docket. Accordingly, the above-captioned proceeding should be closed.
