BY THE HEARING OFFICER:

On February 24, 2009, Windstream Nebraska, Inc. ("Windstream") filed revised pages to the Windstream Nebraska, Inc. General Exchange Tariff, modifying the billing practices in Section 1 of the tariff. The revised tariff provisions became effective on March 5, 2009.

On March 17, 2009, the Nebraska Public Service Commission ("Commission") entered an order opening the above-captioned investigation into the February 24, 2009, Windstream revised tariff. Notice of the docket was published in The Daily Record, Omaha, Nebraska, on March 18, 2009. On March 18, 2009, a Hearing Officer order was entered scheduling a workshop for April 8, 2009. Subsequently, counsel for Windstream requested the workshop be moved to another date due to scheduling conflicts.

Upon review of the matter, I am of the opinion and find that the workshop in the above-captioned matter, scheduled on April 8, 2009, should be moved to **Thursday, April 9, at 10:00 a.m. CDT**, in the Commission Hearing Room, 300 The Atrium Building, 1200 N Street, Lincoln, Nebraska.

On March 30, 2009, a Petition for Formal Intervention was filed by Nebraska Technology and Telecommunications, Inc. ("NT&T"). I being fully advised in the premises find that the petition of NT&T should be granted.


O R D E R
