OPINION AND FINDINGS

On March 17, 2009, the Commission opened the above-captioned investigation to review a tariff provision filed by Windstream Nebraska, Inc. ("Windstream") on February 24, 2009, revising pages to the Windstream Nebraska, Inc. General Exchange Tariff. The new tariff provisions modify the billing practices in Section 1 of the General Exchange Tariff and provide that Windstream will not prorate charges or provide credit for any partial periods when customer initiates service, or if a customer changes, adds or terminates their service on a date prior to the last day of their billing cycle.

The Commission held a workshop in the above-captioned investigation on April 9, 2009, in the Commission Hearing Room for all interested parties.

Based on the comments received at the workshop, Commission believes that a particular rule or regulation mirroring the standard industry practice of prorating customer bills upon initiation, changes, or termination of service would be in the public interest. Accordingly, the Commission will initiate a rulemaking to address the issues raised in the abovecaptioned investigation. The Commission finds that the investigation in Application No. C-4153/PI-148 should be closed.

ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that the investigation in Application No. C-4153/ PI-148 be, and it is hereby, closed.
