BY THE COMMISSION:

On April 6, 2009, an application was filed by NYNEX Long Distance Company d/b/a Verizon Enterprise Solutions ("Verizon"), Arlington, Virginia, seeking a name change to Verizon Enterprise Solutions LLC. Notice of the application was published in The Daily Record, Omaha, Nebraska, on April 8, 2009. No protests were filed; therefore, this application is processed pursuant to the Commission's Rule of Modified Procedure.

O P I N I O N A N D F I N D I N G S

Verizon is a limited liability company with its principal offices located at 1320 N. Courthouse Rd., 6th Floor, Arlington, Virginia 22201. Verizon operates pursuant to a certificate of public convenience and necessity issued by this Commission September 24, 1996, under Docket C-1368 and is subject to the jurisdiction of this Commission.

In the present application, Verizon requests that the Commission enter an order approving the adoption by Verizon of the name "Verizon Enterprise Solutions LLC". Verizon has received authority from the Secretary of State to use the new name. The adoption of the new name will have no effect on the rates, terms or conditions of Verizon's provision of telecommunications services to its customers. Based on the all the evidence adduced, the Commission is of the opinion the application is in the public interest and should be granted.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that Application No. C-4161 be, and it is hereby, granted and the request of NYNEX Long Distance Company d/b/a Verizon Enterprise Solutions to change its name to Verizon Enterprise Solutions LLC is approved.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the applicant file an updated tariff reflecting the change in name within 30 days of the date of this order.
