## BY THE HEARING OFFICER:

On May 4, 2010, the Rural Independent Company (RIC) Intervenors filed a Motion to Strike or Alternatively Seeking Leave to File Surreply Comments in the above-captioned investigation (hereinafter referred to as the "RIC Motion"). The RIC sought an Order of the Commission striking portions of the Qwest Corporation's (Qwest's) post-hearing brief, or in the alternative, an opportunity to file surreply comments in response to Qwest's brief. A response objecting to the RIC Motion was filed by Qwest on May 18, 2010.

Based on the arguments made in the RIC Motion and Qwest's responsive pleading, I find the Motion to Strike should be denied. However, I hereby grant RIC and Qwest an opportunity to file surreply comments concurrently. Surreply comments may be filed on or before **June 7**, **2010**.
