By application filed May 26, 2009, 1-800-Reconex, Inc., d/b/a U.S.Tel, (Reconex) of Hubbard, Oregon, seeks approval to withdraw its authority as a local exchange and interexchange carrier within the State of Nebraska. Notice of the application was published in The Daily Record, Omaha, Nebraska, on May 29, 2009. No protests were filed; therefore, this application is processed pursuant to the Commission's Rule of Modified Procedure.

OPINION AND FINDINGS

By petition received on May 26, 2009, Reconex requested approval to withdraw its authority as a local exchange and interexchange carrier within the State of Nebraska.

In its petition to the Commission, Reconex stated that it would cease normal operations and have no employees on or around May 31, 2009. In a follow-up notice to the Commission filed on May 28, 2009, a representative of Reconex stated that Nebraska customers were sent notice on April 21, 2009, of their requirement to obtain a replacement carrier within 60 days. Reconex did not anticipate having to disconnect any customers.

Upon consideration of the request and being fully advised, the Commission finds the request to be reasonable and finds that Reconex's request to withdraw its authority as a local exchange and interexchange carrier within the State of Nebraska is hereby granted.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that Application No. C-4174 be, and it is hereby, granted.
