#### BY THE COMMISSION:

On July 6, 2009, an application was filed by Kentucky Data Link, Inc. (Applicant), Evansville, Indiana, seeking authority to operate as an interexchange carrier of telecommunications services within the State of Nebraska. Notice of the application was published in <a href="The Daily Record">The Daily Record</a>, Omaha, Nebraska, on July 8, 2009. No protests were filed; therefore, this application is processed pursuant to the Commission's rule of modified procedure.

## OPINION AND FINDINGS

Applicant is a privately held corporation, organized under the laws of the State of Kentucky since April 13, 1990. Applicant has been authorized by the Secretary of State to operate in Nebraska as a foreign corporation. In addition, no officer, director or shareholder having five percent or more of the applicant's voting securities has been involved in a formal complaint or other investigatory or enforcement proceeding.

Applicant is a reseller and facilities-based interexchange carrier of telecommunications services. Applicant proposes to offer switched and dedicated access 1+ long distance services suitable for voice and limited data applications in the state of Nebraska, and intends to construct its infrastructure for provision of its services in Nebraska. time to time, Applicant may offer other services provided by other registered interexchange carriers. Applicant does not propose to provide alternative operator services nor require advanced payments or deposits.

Interexchange applications are subject to Commission jurisdiction under Neb. Rev. Stat. § 86-129 and Title 291 of the Commission's Rules and Regulations, Chapter 5, Rule 003.12. From examination of the application filed herein, the Commission finds that Applicant has provided all the information required by the Commission, possesses adequate financial resources to

provide the proposed service, and possesses adequate technical competency to provide the proposed service. The application should be granted.

## ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that Application No. C-4188 be, and it is hereby, granted and Kentucky Data Link, Inc., is authorized to operate as an interexchange carrier of telecommunications services within the State of Nebraska.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that, to the extent applicable, the applicant shall comply with all laws pertaining to, and all rules and regulations promulgated under, the Telecommunications Relay System Act (Neb.
