By application filed July 6, 2009, Qwest Corporation (Qwest) of Denver, Colorado, seeks approval of a Resale Interconnection Agreement with Easton Telecom Services, LLC, (Easton) of Richfield, Ohio. Notice of the application was published in <a href="The Daily Record">The Daily Record</a>, Omaha, Nebraska, on July 8, 2009. No protests were filed; therefore, this application is processed pursuant to the Commission's Rule of Modified Procedure.
